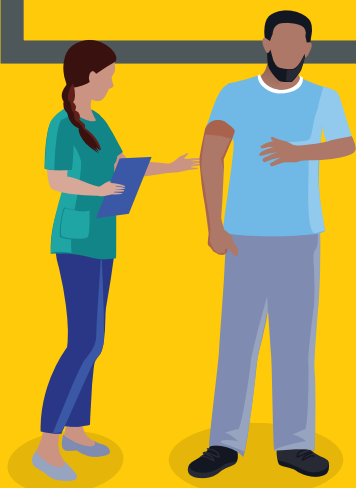


PHYSIOTHERAPY RESEARCH AT MANCHESTER METROPOLITAN UNIVERSITY
